

Regular abstract guidelines

The Organising Committee welcomes the submission of abstracts for presentations at the 3rd International Conference of the German Society of Nursing Science, 11-12 May 2023.

In order to standardise the abstract layout, we kindly ask you to read the guidelines carefully.

Guidelines for preparation abstracts

- 1. Abstracts may only be submitted **online.** Abstracts submitted by fax or email will not be accepted.
- 2. Abstracts must be submitted in English. Please use UK English spelling.
- 3. Abstracts should contain only original material, not published prior the congress.
- 4. The **presenter** of an accepted abstract **must register** and attend the congress.
- 5. Poster presenters must be present and stand by their posters during their assigned poster sessions.
- 6. Provide a short specific title indicating the nature of the investigation or paper.
- 7. The title may not exceed **15 words** including spaces. The abstract **text** may not be longer than **250 words** including spaces, excluding disclosures.
- 8. Images and tables **must not** be included.
- 9. Abstracts for individual presentations and posters should be structured as follows:
 - Background
 - Objectives
 - Design and Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- 10. All **abbreviations must be defined** the first time they appear in the text.
- 11. If studies are submitted, results should already be available when the abstract is submitted. Abstracts in which results are promised will not be accepted.
- 12. Authors should indicate their presentation type preference:
 - Oral presentation (15 minutes)
 - Symposium (60 or 90 minutes) (please refer to separate guidelines)
 - Workshop (60 or 90 minutes)
 - Poster presentation (5 minutes)
 - The review board reserves the right to decide on the final allocation and presentation type.
- 13. Disclosure of potential conflict of interest (e.g. grant support, consultancy, membership on advisory boards) by all authors and source of funding are mandatory. Each listed author should prepare a one-sentence statement to this effect.
- 14. Please make sure to state your **correct e-mail** address. After having submitted your abstract, you will receive a confirmation e-mail. **If you do not receive a confirmation please contact** info@dg-pflegewissenschaft.de.
- 15. Should you wish to make corrections to an abstract already submitted, please contact info@dgpflegewissenschaft.de. If you wish to submit other abstracts later, you may use your personal access code.

Submitting an abstract and corrections to abstracts can only be made up to the deadline of 15th November 2022, CET 23.59.



Abstract topics

- Methodological issues of nursing research
 - Methodological challenges, solutions and innovations in nursing and interprofessional research
- Theory development
 - Theoretical approaches and developments for nursing, nursing research and nursing practice
- Clinical nursing
 - o Development, evaluation and implementation of interventions in different nursing settings
- Nursing in times of crisis
 - Climate change, pandemic and sustainability in nursing research and practice

Notification

Each abstract will be reviewed by 2 experts according to relevance, originality, clarity, and scientific quality of the submitted abstract. Final selection will be made by the review board. Notification of acceptance or rejection of submitted abstracts will be sent to the corresponding authors via email in December 2022. Full instructions concerning preparation and presentation will be included.

Publication

All accepted abstracts will be published. By submitting an abstract the author gives permission for publication.

Late Breaking Abstracts

Late Breaking News abstracts containing new information or important findings not (fully) available before the general abstract deadline, can be submitted until Monday, 13 February 2023. Please note that the Late Breaking News abstract deadline is not an extension of the general abstract submission deadline.

The Late Breaking News abstract submission will open after the regular abstract submission closes and the process for submitting Late Breaking News abstracts will be similar to regular abstracts. Notification of acceptance or rejection of submitted Late Breaking News abstracts will be sent to the corresponding authors via e-mail end of February 2023.
